

INVITATION TO BID
EPC Contract for 60 MW Solar PV

Description of procurement:

The Bangladesh-China Renewable Energy Company (BCRECL) has invited bids for engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) of a 60 MW solar project on a turnkey basis at Pabna, Bangladesh.

The Company is a joint venture between the North-West Power Generation Company, a subsidiary of the Bangladesh Power Development Board, and China National Machinery Import and Export Corporation.

Scope of the Work:

The scope of work includes the design, engineering, procurement, supply, installation, erection, testing, and commissioning of the 60 MW solar project. The successful bidder must also construct a 37 kilometer long 132 kV double circuit transmission line with substation bay extension on a turnkey basis.

Requirements:

The requirements for bidders are:

- the bidder should have experience as a contractor for at least seven years before the bid submission date
- The bidder must have executed at least two solar projects outside his own country, each with a minimum capacity of 50 MW within the last five years. The said project should have been in operation for at least one year before the bid opening date.
- The minimum average annual turnover of bidders must be \$100 million during the past three financial years. The bidder's financial resources must meet or exceed the total requirement of \$30 million for the project.
