Description of procurement:

The consultant will focus on (i) the development of wind and solar resources in South Gobi; (ii) Mongolia People's Republic of China (PRC) interconnection; (iii) the business cases of exporting renewable electricity from Mongolia to the PRC and the possibility of linking such exports to the planned trade between the PRC and the Republic of Korea (ROK); (iv) underlying policy, regulatory and electricity market environments in Mongolia, the PRC and the ROK; and (v) evaluating other opportunities for using the South Gobi Renewable Energy resources, such as for the production of green hydrogen either for exports to the PRC or Mongolia's domestic use. The consultant will assist Mongolia to carry out the necessary planning and develop associated business models. The consultant will continue and intensify dialogue between the potential trading partners and among various regional stakeholders on interconnectivity development. The consultant will also contribute to the development of project investment pipelines to be financed by ADB.

Scope of Work:

In close coordination with the Ministry of Energy (MOE), an international consulting firm hired by ADB to lead the analysis, and other individual consultants, the expert will:

- (i) support stakeholder dialogue in the TA activities.
- (ii) support the organization of workshops and meetings, including taking the lead for any events within Mongolia.
- (iii) coordinate with other regional coordinators to ensure relevant participation in all related events, taking the lead for ensuring the participation of relevant Mongolian stakeholders.
- (iv) support the Mongolian Transmission Planning Specialist with data collection, if needed.
- (v) support MOE's role as chair of the Energy Charter for 2022; and
- (vi) any other support as needed.

Qualification Criteria:

The experts should have a postgraduate degree or equivalent in business administration, regional study, and/or engineering; (ii) good written and verbal communication skills in English; (iii) strong understanding of Mongolian stakeholders relevant for the NAPSI initiative; and (iii) good interpersonal and networking skills.
