

## GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

ZAMBIA

Wind Power Promotion Project

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1. The *Republic of Zambia* has received a *grant* from the African Development Bank to finance the *Wind Power Promotion Project*.
2. The principal objective of this project is to *determine the feasibility of 40 MW grid-connected wind power plant on three (3) potential sites in order to assess possible wind system development and estimate the construction cost, assessment of tariff, performance, and site impacts. Consulting services under the project will be selected using the Quality and Cost Based (QCBS) Procurement Method.*
3. The project includes the following components:
  - i. *Undertake technical assessments on three (3) potential sites from the eight sites assessed during the ESMAP resource assessment program*
  - ii. *Undertake full feasibility Studies on one viable site for the development of the 40 MW grid-connected wind power plant and,*
  - iii. *Undertake due diligence on the development of the regulatory framework for wind, and*
  - iv. *Develop a techno-economic report for the proposed wind project’.*
4. The Procurement of Goods and Services, financed by the Bank, will be carried out in accordance with the Bank’s Procurement Policy for Bank Group Funded Operations dated October 2015 and in line with the provisions stated in the Grant Agreement. Bidding documents are expected to be available in May 2023.
